Tips on Preparing for Reptiles Alive Big Group Party Shows

- 1. Close PARKING must be available for the RA wildlife educator when he/she arrives so the animals may be safely loaded to the performance area.
- 2. Allow the educator access to the performance area at least 15 minutes prior to the show start time and have a responsible adult keep children and adults away from the performance area while the educator unloads and sets up.
- 3. The largest room with the least amount of furniture will be the best place to perform your show.
- 4. Plan on having your show indoors. We can perform outside if the temperature is above 65 F and there is shade.
- 5. Electrical access must be available within 25 feet of the performance area.
- 6. Please remove all pets (except fish) from the show area before we arrive.
- 7. Please do not allow children or adults to walk behind, to the side, or within 6 feet of the educator during the program. (This is the gray area labeled "no people zone")
- 9. Start the party at least 30 minutes prior to the start time of the Reptiles Alive show.
- 10. Tipping the educator for a job well done is appreciated.

If Reptile Encounters has been booked along with the show:

- 1. Please provide a 1-2 tables
- 2. All participants must wash their hands with soap and water after touching animals. Adults should supervise younger children to make sure hand washing is done correctly.
