

Tips on Preparing for Reptiles Alive Large Audience Shows

1. Provide close PARKING for the RA wildlife educator when he/she arrives so the animals may be safely loaded to the performance area.
2. Allow the educator access to the performance area at least 30 minutes prior to the show start time.
3. Shows are best performed from an elevated stage. If no stage is available, we can set up at one end of a room where there are no doors being used behind or to the side of the performance area.
4. Outside shows can only be presented when the temperature is above 60 degrees F and there is shade for the performance area.
5. Electrical access must be available within 25 feet of the performance area.
6. Please provide tables -- either two 6 foot tables or one 12 foot table.
7. Please notify us in advance if there are STAIRS between the parking area and the performance space.

If Reptile Encounters have been booked along with the show:

1. Food/drinks should not be served/consumed during the Encounter session.
2. Hand washing facilities must be available nearby.
